



## Ableism: Undergirds the hierarchy of human health



Physicians Perceptions of People with Disabilities and Their Healthcare

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82% 82% 82% of Physicians reported they believed that people with significant disabilities have worse quality of life

than non-disabled people

40% Only 40% of Physicians were very confident about their ability to provide the same guality

Just 56.5% strongly agreed that they welcomed patients with a disability into their practices






## A critical barrier to workforce diversity



Only 3% of practicing physicians report having a disability




#### Physicians reporting disabilities
